

Fukagawa/深川 ふかがわ

The map highlights several key areas and attractions:

- Morishita 森下**: Features the Toei Shinjuku Line station and various local businesses like Taiyaki (たい焼き) and Morishita Cultural Center (Norakukan).
- Sumida River Terrace 濱田川テラス**: Located along the Sumida River.
- Basho Memorial Hall 江東区芭蕉記念館**: A historical site related to Matsuo Basho.
- Basho Inari Shrine 芭蕉稲荷神社**: Another shrine dedicated to Matsuo Basho.
- Basho Memorial Hall Annex 苔葉記念館 分館**: A smaller branch of the main hall.
- Takadagawa-Beya (Sumo-Beya)**: Located near the Nishikawabashi Bridge.
- Oguruma-Beya (Sumo-Beya)**: Located near the Takahashi Boarding Area.
- Kiyosumi Shirakawa 清澄白河**: A neighborhood featuring the Kiyosumi Garden (清澄庭園), Taisho Memorial Hall (大正記念館), and Shikoroyama-Beya (Sumo-Beya).
- Taiho Dojo Otake-Beya (Sumo-Beya)**: Located near the Kiyosumi Park (清澄公園).
- Aoba-do (pottery) 青葉堂 (陶器)**: A pottery workshop.
- Fukagawa Edo Museum 深川江戸資料館**: A museum dedicated to the history of Edo.
- Fukagawajuku (Fukagawa-Meshi)**: An old宿 (post town) on the Tōkaidō.
- Beer Specialty Store ビール専門店**: A shop specializing in beer.
- Rikashitsu リカシツ**: A shop selling traditional Japanese ceramics.
- Blue Bottle Coffee ブルーボトルコーヒー**: A coffee shop.
- All Press Espresso オールプレス・エスプレッソ**: Another coffee shop.
- Ando Gallery アンドーギャラリー**: An art gallery.
- Duck bakery あひるのパン屋さん**: A bakery.
- To Ryogoku 全国丼**: A restaurant.
- Cattleya's Original Curry Bread カトレアの元祖カレーパン**: A bakery.
- To Monzennakacho 至 門前仲町**: A street name.
- To Suitengumae 至 水天宮前**: A street name.
- To Hamacho 浜町**: A street name.
- To Sumiyoshi 至 住吉**: A street name.
- To Kiba Park 木場公園**: A park.
- Kiba Park Bridge 木場公園大橋**: A bridge.
